FROM THE PASTOR'S STUDY

I will extol you, my God and King, and bless your name forever and ever.

Every day I will bless you, and praise your name forever and ever.

Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised; his greatness is unsearchable. One generation shall laud your works to another, and shall declare your mighty acts.

Psalm145:1-4 (NRSV)

Sometimes I worry that we are less and less able or willing to laud God's works and God's mighty acts to another generation. The assumption behind the Psalm is that we will do just that. And I think we intend to do it, too. But when I look at the trends in our church, and in most churches I know of, I am afraid I might be seeing something else.

We have a really good and healthy Sunday school program in our church, and I am grateful to all those who help with that, and to those who make sure their children are here, receiving an education that they will get nowhere else.

At the same time, I wonder if in our homes it is God who is extolled, and whose name is blessed and praised. And I wonder this because so many people participate in events that are scheduled at the same time as our weekly worship. Sometimes it is recreation, sometimes it is organized

athletics, sometimes it may be other things that are being lauded and extolled in our homes.

And that makes me wonder if we are willing and able to laud God's works and mighty acts to another generation. I suspect that if that next generation is not in church on Sunday morning, all that lauding and extolling will not happen.

If your kids are in Sunday school, that is great. They will get a great education there. But faith formation takes place over many years by constant attention and concentration on our story. And when we send kids to Sunday school, but do not worship with them as a whole congregation, it sends the signal to kids that the Christian faith is for children only, as if it is something one can outgrow.

It is important that we worship together as families, not just once in a while—not just when it is convenient. Not just when there is nothing else scheduled. It is important that we understand that we are the people who make such gatherings a (the) priority. If we don't, there is little hope that another generation will. And then what will we have achieved?

I would guess that most families would not have great confidence in their ability to pass the faith on, in a way that is faithful to our beliefs, to the next generation, all on their own. And no family is expected to do that.

We are all in this together. We are here for—among other things—that very purpose.

The thing that should make this easier and better for us than perhaps others is that in our church we have an outstanding Sunday school (for children and adults) and we have times in our worship service that are particularly focused on the children and their learning and their faith and their songs.

It is an act of love toward us when God calls us together to worship. And it is an act of love toward our children when we make sure we worship with them on Sunday mornings.

Besides, if you are not here, we miss you!
